


TRANSPORTATION ADVENTURES




June 8th – June 26th

Old MacDonald has a farm—and so much to care for!




THE POWER OF ATTRACTION


July 13th – July 31st

During this session, children will explore the amazing world of magnets and the forces that make them pull, push, and attract objects without even touching them. They will discover how magnets come in different shapes and sizes, and learn which materials are magnetic and which are non-magnetic.

Through exciting activities, experiments, and creative projects, children will witness the power of attraction in action, develop curiosity, and make connections to the science all around them. From everyday objects to fun challenges, this session is full of discovery and hands-on learning!
